Reading Hope Tracts touched the hearts of Kalenga and Jefferson and they met Christ.

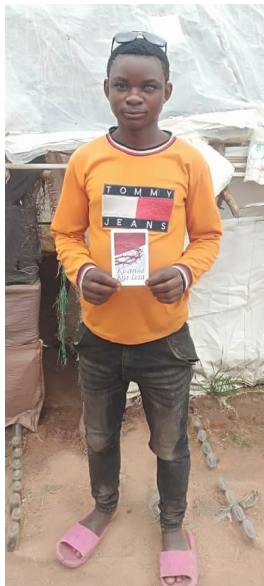


KATALA VILLAGE

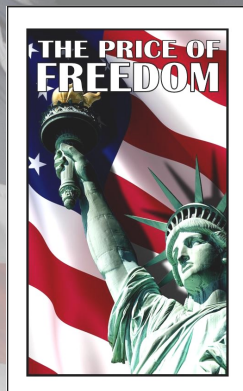
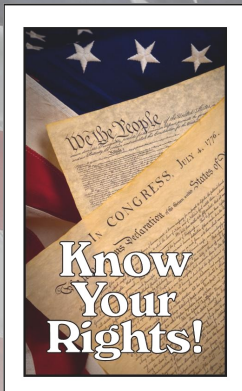
