



DR. IN UK WITTS HIS FAMILY IN MALAYSIA

Pictured below is Chik Kaw Tan, a doctor living in the United Kingdom. In our January - February prayer letter I mentioned our rushing Chinese tracts to him in time to take on his trip to Malaysia to see his 95-year-old father who only reads and speaks Chinese. He received the tracts in time and wrote back a very detailed report of how God continually opened doors for him to witness to his family members with these tracts. Here are a few excerpts from his letter:



"I gave two of the tracts to my 95 year old father (pictured right). He was staying with my sister and brother-in-law who are not Christians and it could have been awkward. But I woke up one morning and my sister and husband happened to be out early. And guess who was sitting in the living room by himself looking bored? My father! I gave him a couple of tracts and he started reading them. He's very well educated and loves reading. He's virtually deaf but of sound mind. Just as he finished and put them into his pocket (not disposed of by leaving on table!) my sister and her husband came back. Praise the Lord - what timing!"



"I gave a tract or two to my sprightly and mentally sharp 95 year old aunt. She started reading it and seemed interested. Here's another amazing story. When I went to visit her, my non-Christian sister and brother-in-law insisted on driving me there. But I wanted to be alone with my aunt to speak to her. I forgot that my cousin would be there the entire time as he is her full time caregiver. He's not a Christian and would probably object to my giving his mother a tract. Guess what happened? At some point during my visit my sister and brother-in-law were engaged in an animated conversation with my cousin, leaving me momentarily alone with my aunt. This was when I gave her the tracts. What divine intervention! Please pray for their salvation. I'm deeply distressed for them. Thank you for the tools you gave me and for the writers and your church financing this ministry...I will need more Chinese tracts from you!"
