
TRANSPORT FOR CHRIST USING JOHN & ROMANS



SHARE THE GOSPEL MINISTRY REACHING STUDENTS

Carl and Danie Erickson have a ministry of traveling to colleges and universities throughout the United States and distributing gospel tracts directly to the students. Their ministry began in 2014 in Hot Springs, Arkansas, with the simple goal of sharing the gospel with locals and visitors to this tourist town. Over time, people in their church and other churches as well joined their ministry. Now over three hundred people have joined in person and over three hundred on their own in other states and countries. To date, they have traveled to thirty five states and more than three hundred universities and colleges, as well as numerous high schools sharing gospel tracts. In 2020, they sold their belongings and went on the road full-time and have been using our gospel tracts for several years now. Carl recently wrote:



"Please tell your supporters that God is on the move out here! We hand tracts out! Even in Arizona and New Mexico we found most people will take a tract when we simply say "something out of the Bible for you" in a friendly way and with that smile Jesus gave us when He saved us! On our recent trip this Spring to University of Houston; Sam Houston State; Texas A&M; University of Texas San Antonio; University of Texas El Paso; New Mexico State University; University of Arizona; and Arizona State University, we had the privilege of sharing over 70,000 gospel tracts. We also went to 20 or so High Schools.

We can use any prayer or financial support you or your friends may be able to help with as we totaled out our 99 Sportsmen pull-behind trailer in Dallas last Tuesday. We are homeless at the moment, but we know God will provide as He always does for His chil-
