
Mormons believe that only they can be saved. Brigham Young said, "Will all the people be damned who are not Latter-Day Saints? Yes, and a great many of them except they repent speedily". (Journal of Discourses-vol. of Mormon Sermons, Vol. 1, pg. 339)

The Bible states that anyone can be saved. "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved." "For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." Romans 10:9,10,13

Are Mormons Christians? Not according to the Word of God. "Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;" 1 Timothy 4:1



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A Christian is one who has received Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and follows His teachings found in the Bible. In contrast, a Mormon follows the teachings of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints found in their own "sacred" writings such as the "The Book of Mormon", the "Pearl of Great Price", "Doctrine and Covenants", and many others.

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The "Latter Day Saints" (LDS) began in 1830 when Joseph Smith claimed to have discovered golden plates which became the Book of Mormon after the angel Moroni appeared to him, revealing their location. Some of their false teachings are that Jesus and Lucifer (Satan) were brothers, that God the Father is Adam, and that men can become gods and populate planets with their children forever. Their beliefs are so wild that they dare not reveal them until their converts are thoroughly entrapped.

Don't let their slick TV commercials and their support of family values fool you. The Bible they claim to believe reveals their teachings to be lies. We will examine 4 of their beliefs, which identify them as a cult and an antichrist.

Mormons believe Adam became God the Father. Brigham Young taught that Adam was promoted to be the god of this world: "He (Adam) is our Father and our God, and the only God with whom we have to do." (Journal of Discourses-vol. of Mormon Sermons, Vol. 1, pg. 50)

The Bible states that God the Father and Christ existed in glory before the world was created. Jesus prayed in John 17:5: "And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was."

Mormons believe in many gods that will have children throughout eternity. "Each god, through his wife or wives, raises up a numerous family of sons and daughters,...for each father and mother will be in a condition to multiply forever and ever". (The Seer, 1, 37).

The Bible states there is only one God! "I am the LORD, and there is none else, there is no God beside me..." Isaiah 45:5
Jesus said there would be no marriage in Heaven. "For when they shall rise from the dead, they neither marry nor are given in marriage; but are as the angels which are in heaven". Mark 12:25

Mormons believe in salvation by works.

"Redemption from personal sins can only be obtained through obedience to the requirements of the Gospel (Mormon ceremonies) and a life of good works." (Book of Mormon, Alma, 42:23).
"The sectarian doctrine of justification by faith alone

"The sectarian doctrine of justification by faith alone has exercised an influence for evil since the early days of Christianity." (Talmage's Articles of Faith, p. 120)

The Bible states salvation is by grace through faith and not of works. Salvation is a gift of God and cannot be earned. "Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:" Romans 3:24

"For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast." Ephesians 2:8-9 "Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us..." Titus 3:5
