

There are times of grief in our life when we ask ourselves, "Why is this happening to me? Is God punishing me for something I've done?" Some wonder this after finding out they have cancer; others wonder this after the death of a child or another family member. God does correct His children in different ways. However, when this is the purpose, we will know it.

There are times when we can look back years later and see God's purpose in allowing these circumstances to take place, while other times we won't know why until after this life is over. Grief is one of the ways God uses to teach us important spiritual lessons.

To the mother and father whose child has died, grief leads them to depend upon God for strength. "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble." Psalm 46:1

To the young person left paralyzed after an accident, grief teaches them that their soul is more important than their ambitions.

"For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?" Mark 8:36 To those stricken with cancer and the elderly who suffer daily with pain, grief loosens the hold of our affections on this world and prepares us for the world to come.

"Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth." Colossians 3:2

If you are a child of God, Jesus has promised to go with you through your suffering. "I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me." Hebrews 13:5-6

If you are a child of God, He has called you to be conformed to the image of His Son and identify with His suffering. It is a difficult lesson to learn, but we are to count it a privilege to do so. "For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to believe on him, but also to suffer for his sake;" Philippians 1:29
