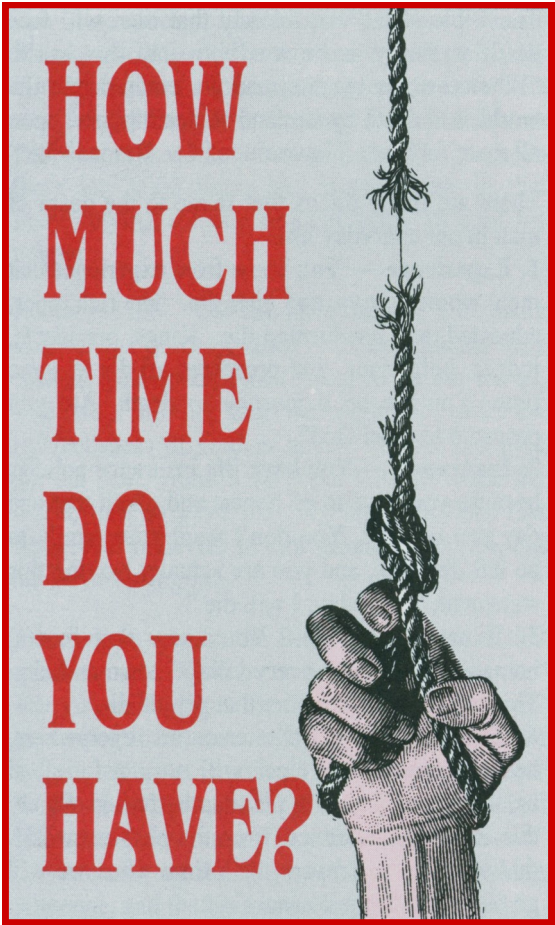

The Bible states very clearly that man will face death as surely as he was born into this world. “Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned.” Romans 5:12

There are many things that relate to the death of man in our everyday life.
