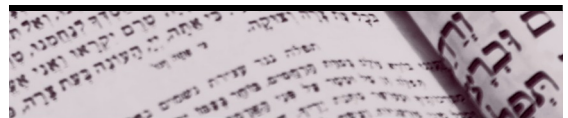

What Every Hebrew Should Know



Prophecy: Isaiah 7:14 —“Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.”

N.T. Fulfillment: Matthew 1:22-23 —“Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.” John 1:14 —“And the Word (Messiah) was made flesh, and dwelt among us...”

Prophecy: Isaiah 9:6-7 —“For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David...”

N.T. Fulfillment: Luke 1:32-33 —“He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David: And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end.”

Prophecy: Deuteronomy 18:15 —“The LORD thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken;”

N.T. Fulfillment: Acts 3:22 & 26 —“For Moses truly said unto the fathers, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you...Unto you first God, having raised up his Son Jesus, sent him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities.”

Prophecy: Isaiah 53:3 —“He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.”

N.T. Fulfillment: John 1:11 —“He came unto his own, and his own received him not.”

Prophecy: Isaiah 53:4 —“Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.”

N.T. Fulfillment: 1 Peter 2:21-24 —“...because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps: Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously: Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.”

Prophecy: Isaiah 53:10 — “Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.”

N.T. Fulfillment: II Corinthians 5:21—“For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.”

Zechariah prophesied that He would be sold for a few pieces of silver. Micah prophesied His birth in Bethlehem. Daniel prophesied when the Messiah would die. There is much that every Hebrew should know about the Messiah because it will determine where his soul will spend eternity.
