“Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out...” Acts 3:19

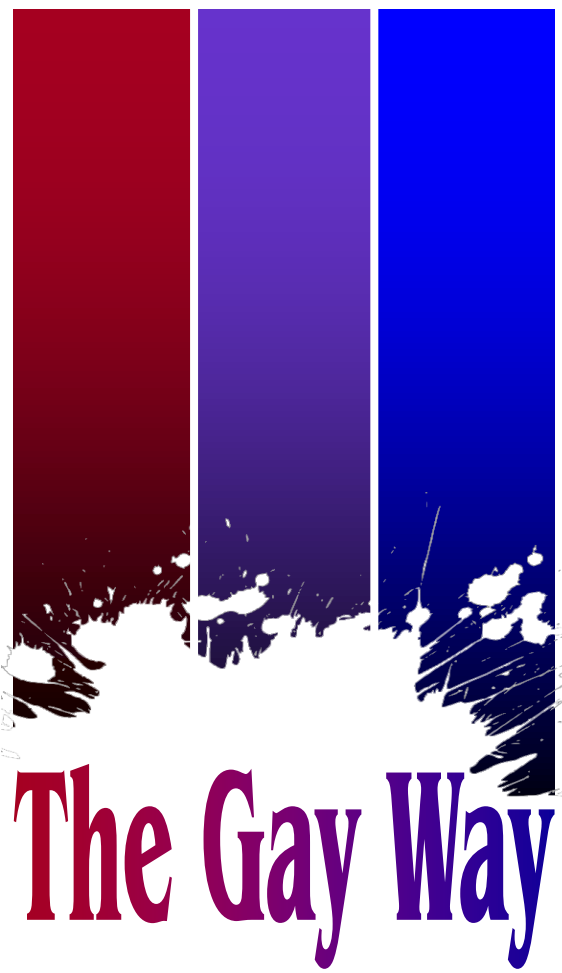
Don't be fooled into thinking you can continue going “the gay way” and be saved.

God has commanded us not to go "the gay way."
"Thou shalt not lie with mankind, as with woman-kind: it is abomination." Leviticus 18:22

When man followed God's law it was a capital offence! *"If a man also lie with mankind, as he lieth with a woman, both of them have committed an abomination: they shall surely be put to death; their blood shall be upon them."* Leviticus 20:13
