It is very interesting to note that in this Ayah from the Injeel Sharif, Hazrat Isa Al-Masih did not say that He will get peace from Allah Taala and give it to his followers. Instead he says "MY PEACE I GIVE UNTO YOU!" In other words, Hazrat Isa Al-Masih owns peace.

In my desperate need and search for peace, shall I become a follower of Hazrat Isa Al-Masih so that I can finally have the peace I have been craving for all my life?

Dear Friend, your search for peace can come to a great end right now if you will become a follower of Hazrat Isa Al-Masih (the Lord Jesus Christ) and ask for peace in His name. He promised His followers, "If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it." (Injeel Sharif, Surah Yahya [John] 14:14). "And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus." (Injeel Sharif, Surah [Philippians] 4:7).
