fled away...And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened ...And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire."

This appointment can be cancelled.

Those who believe with all their heart that Jesus paid the penalty for their sin by dying on the cross, being buried, and three days later rising from the grave, and confess Him, are forgiven. God makes us a promise in Romans 10:9, "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved."

Don't wait until it's too late!

Cancel this appointment while there is still time. In eternity it will be too late.
