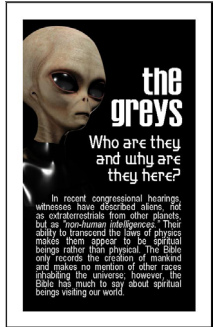

"Dear friends, I praise the Lord for the good work you are doing to spread the Gospel through the tracts all over the world, especially in Africa Kenya. We are located in Kenya Eldoret slum, Uasing Gishu County. Whereby we started fellowship here at the

name Cherus Baptist Church. We are now three years since we started and we've seen the hand of God. Most of the people we are dealing with are called Ongienk families. They come from (Kalenjin tribe in Kenya.) They usually stay in bush (forest) and now the government of Kenya relocated them from the forest and they were given a place to call home. We are now trying to teach them the Word of God, and also educate them too. The challenges that we are facing are not having enough Bibles and tracts. We humbly request for your help and support. Even second hand clothes and shoes if possible. It will help us to reach them in larger numbers."

We have shipped them Swahili tracts. If anyone would like to help with the other items, please let us know.

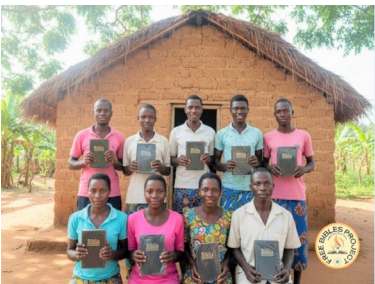
